

Funding Guidelines

PURPOSE

The Energy Foundation Corporation is a non-profit corporation organized to seek out and provide funds for charitable purposes that include:

- 1. Making grants to members who cannot pay their REC electric bills
- 2. Providing financial assistance for weatherization and energy conservation to REC members
- 3. Awarding one-time COMMUNITY GRANTS to:

Those supporting community economic development efforts Those assisting civic programs and organizations that enhance local communities

FUNDING

Funds are distributed quarterly following Board review of project applications.

COMMUNITY GRANT ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Requests must be for charitable, educational or non-profit organizations only
- 2. Non-profit organizations that serve communities located within REC service areas
- 3. One application per project or event accepted each year
- 4. Charitable status or 501 (c) (#) organizations
- 5. Application must be for a project or event in the future (will not grant projects in the past)
- 6. Projects should fit in one or more of the following categories: Community Service, Economic Development, Education/Youth Development and/or Disaster Relief

EVALUATION FACTORS

- 1. The following factors will be considered in the evaluation of all funding requests:
 - •Potential benefit to area residents and the entire community
 - •Level of community support for the program or project
 - •Administrative capability of the organization to deliver quality service or program
 - •Lower priority may be given to applications from organizations who have been awarded a REC Community Grant within the past 24 months
- 2. It shall be the responsibility of all Foundation Directors to evaluate funding requests and allocate contributions to accomplish the purposes and intent of these guidelines

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Completed application form
- 2. Detailed budget showing how requested funds would be spent
- 3. If organization is a non-profit, please provide copy of IRS determination letter
- 4. Any additional information pertaining to your project to include in application review
