# **Application Deadline**

Please mail your completed application to San Luis Valley Rural Electric Cooperative, Inc., P.O. Box 3625, Monte Vista, CO 81144. You may also drop it off at our office located at 3625 US Hwy 160 W, approximately three miles west of Monte Vista or email to jalonzo@slvrec.com. *All applications must be received in the office no later than 5 p.m. on February 3*, 2025.

Please read each application criteria carefully. Your application must include the required attachments and appropriate essay with a letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or employer with a signature. Applications that are not filled out correctly with all of the listed requirements will not be considered.

### **General Eligibility Requirements**

- The student or the student's parents or legal guardian must be an active member\* who receives electric service from SLVREC. If the service is listed under a farm or business name, please provide that name. Applicant's parents must be owners. (Additional information may be requested to verify membership.) \*The lineworker scholarship is open to non-members as well.
- Unless stated otherwise for a specific scholarship, the student must be graduating from a local area high school (or equivalent), and the student must be entering college or vocational school as a freshman.
- If funding is available Adams State University sophomores, juniors or seniors may be considered for the Adams State University Scholarship.
- Dependents of SLVREC board members and employees are only eligible for the Basin Scholarship specifically identified for dependents.
- Applicants will be rated on grade point average (GPA), SAT/ACT score, school and community activities, achievements and an essay stating his/her career goals (two pages maximum). Lineworker applicants' rating system varies slightly.

\*\*\*All scholarships awarded must be used the same year they are granted. \*\*\*

## **Scholarships Available**

#### Martin Christensen Memorial Lineworker Scholarship, \$5,500

One scholarship is available and <u>may be used at any accredited Lineworker School.</u> The value of this scholarship is \$5,500 and is distributed in a one-time payment at the beginning of the school year. This scholarship is to cover tuition costs; the balance can be used for required textbooks or climbing gear/basic tools for the electrical lineworker program. The recipient will be responsible for other associated costs: boots, required tools and climbing gear. Please inquire at the school if they have a tool purchase program. Receiving this scholarship does not automatically guarantee hiring from SLVREC.

\*\*You do not need to be a member of SLVREC to apply.\*\*

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

SLVREC's Lineworker Scholarship will provide the required training for the recipient to become an apprentice lineworker or electric lineworker.

- Must be at least 18 years old
- The student must enroll in the program full-time and maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5.
- Although first consideration will be given to graduating high school seniors, this scholarship is open to all individuals.

#### SLVREC's Adams State University Four-Year Scholarship

One scholarship is available

This scholarship is renewable for up to a maximum of four years. The value of the scholarship will equal the total of in-state tuition, college service fees and a \$700 book allowance for the award year with one-half awarded at the beginning of each semester. (Total value awarded will equal four years of undergraduate tuition.)

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

In addition to the general eligibility requirements, students wishing to compete for the Four-Year Scholarship to Adams State University must also:

- Pursue a major in a degree program offered at ASU
- Register as a full-time student at ASU and maintain a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or better. A minimum of 12 credit hours must be completed each semester; although a 15-credit hour load is encouraged.
- At the end of each semester, the recipient must mail a copy of his/her transcript to SLVREC to renew the scholarship.
- The recipient may renew the scholarship for up to a maximum of four consecutive years of study as long as the minimum GPA, class load criteria and career goals are maintained.
- Applicant must be an incoming freshman who graduated from high school or equivalent in the counties SLVREC serves: Alamosa, Costilla, Conejos, Hinsdale, Mineral, Rio Grande or Saguache.
- ASU sophomores, juniors or seniors may be considered for a scholarship if all other applications do not meet general criteria requirements and they meet all other previously mentioned criteria.
- Relatives of board members and employees of SLVREC are not eligible for this scholarship.

#### Robert Wolfe Scholarship, \$4,000

One scholarship is available.

The recipient will receive a one-time award of \$4,000 from SLVREC & the Robert Wolfe family. This scholarship was established for students furthering their education in an <u>agricultural or engineering field</u> and may be used at *any* trade school, college or university. However, if there are no students majoring in agriculture or an engineering field, it will then go to another applicant.

#### Michael Rierson Scholarship, \$4,000

One scholarship is available.

The recipient will receive a one-time award of \$4,000 from SLVREC & the Michael Rierson family. This scholarship may be used toward furthering education at *any* trade school, college or university.

#### James & Thomas Magness Scholarship, \$4,000

One scholarship is available.

The recipient will receive a one-time award of \$4,000 from SLVREC & the James and Thomas Magness family. This scholarship was established for students furthering their education in an <u>electrical field</u> (<u>electrician</u>; <u>electrical-contractor</u>, <u>engineering or lineman</u>; <u>communications tech</u>, <u>etc.</u> at *any* trade school, college or university. However, if there are no students majoring in an electrical field, it will then go to another applicant in a STEM (Science Technology Engineering Math) field.

#### SLVREC Past Director Scholarship, \$2,500

One scholarship is available.

The recipient will receive a one-time award of of \$2,000 from SLVREC and \$500 from Tri-State. This scholarship may be used toward furthering education at *any* trade school, college or university.

# SLVREC Past Retired GM Ray Villyard & CEO John Villyard Scholarship, \$2,500

One scholarship is available.

The recipient will receive a one-time award of \$2,000 from SLVREC and \$500 from Tri-State. This scholarship may be used toward furthering education at *any* trade school, college or university.

#### Basin Electric Power Cooperative Scholarship, \$1,000

One scholarship is available.

The recipient will receive a one-time award of \$1,000. The scholarship must be used for educational costs, and the student must enter college in the fall of the school year for which the scholarship is given. BEPC will pay the scholarship in two equal installments: the first installment in June (during SLVREC's annual meeting) and the second installment in December.

The recipient must be a student who is enrolled or planning to enroll in a full-time graduate or undergraduate course of study at an accredited, two-year, four-year college/university or vocational/technical school.
